Tasks to "Sign Up" for !!

CVO's will be given a monetary grant
in proportion to the amount of time
their volunteers spend on behalf of the derby.

HALL SET UP- Thursday or Friday (during the day- time to be determined closer to the date)

Tables & chairs to be set up, signage to be placed & hung. (*Approx 4-6 People required.*)

HALL CLEAN UP - March 12, Saturday (post event 3:30-5:00pm)

Tables cleared & clean, garbage collected & chairs stacked. (*Approx 4-6 people required.*)

DERBY TENT (set up)- March 11, Friday 12:00 -1:30pm

Assistance is required to help set up our tent at the end of the Town dock. We will bring the tools/materials required, we just need some helping hands to set it up. (*Approx. 6-8 people are required.*)

HOLE DRILLING- March 11, Friday 9:30am -12:00pm

We already have a group from the senior school that are doing the pre-drilling, but a few people to walk behind the kids to ensure that if an auger goes down, they can assist in starting it again. Running with gas, ensuring the gridline rope is tight is also a huge help. (*Approx 5-7 people are required.*)

HOLE DRILLING- March 12, Saturday 6:30am -8:30am

25 Augers are provided, you just need to know how to operate them and enjoy an early morning start!!
(*Approx 25 people are required.*)

MEASURING FISH- March 12, Saturday 10:30am - 1:30pm

If you don't mind touching a fish, like the outdoors and enjoy a fun atmosphere then this very social task is for you!!
We will provide you with the all equipment you need as well as a quick indoor information session before the start of the event.
We send you off in groups of two, one to measure and one to write down the information. (*Approx. 26 people are required.*)

DERBY TENT (take down)- March 13, Sunday 12:00 -1:30pm

Assistance is required to help take down our tent at the end of the Town dock. We will bring the tools/materials required, we just need some helping hands to take it down. (*Approx. 4 people are required.*)

OUTDOOR CLEAN UP (post event)- March 12, Saturday 1:30 -2:30pm

Assistance is required for the clean up of the ice surface & registration areas after the event is over. Debris picked up and disposed of and garbage barrels to be brought onto the dock. Markers & signage removed from the ice surface etc.
(*Approx 4 people are required.*)
