Lac du Bonnet Ice Fishing Derby 2012 Rules

- All provisions of the Manitoba Fishery Regulations must be adhered to.
- DERBY SPECIFIC RULES:**
 - Electronic devices are prohibited.
 - Participants are restricted to the use of one ice-fishing hole per entry ticket and may purchase no more than two tickets in their name.
 - Participants may not angle with entry tickets purchased in the name of other individuals. Tickets purchased prior to the start of the event may be transferred to another individual at registration desk on the day of the event.
 - Only those anglers with entry tickets may angle and may not have any other person angle on their behalf at any time during the derby.
 - Participants may use only one rod and line with a maximum of two hooks.
 - At the discretion of the Lac du Bonnet Ice Fishing Derby Committee, ice fishing portable tents may be used due to inclement weather. The decision to permit the use of portable tents will be made forty eight (48) hours prior to the start of the event and will be posted on the derby website at www.lacdubonnetchamber.com
 - In the event portable tents are allowed, doors must remain open at all times.
 - Only ticket holders and derby officials are permitted in the designated fishing area.
- Anglers must be pre-registered prior to fishing. Start time will be at 10:30 a.m.

LOCATION: Lac du Bonnet Town Dock (Park Ave.)

- ENTRY FEES:**
 - \$50.00 adults
 - \$40.00 teens (13 -17 yrs)
 - \$30.00 children (12 and under)

- PRIZE AWARD PROCEDURE:**

The first five prizes will be awarded based on pre-determined randomly selected hidden lengths and times of fish angled in the event, independent of species. The random lengths and associated times are determined by an independent person prior to the start of the event, sealed in an envelope and secured with the R.C.M.P. until the derby is completed. Following completion of the derby, the envelope is opened by derby officials and the five lengths and times are compared to the entries to determine the winners. An entry is eligible for one prize only (the prize with the higher value) in the hidden length and time category. The remaining prizes (6-50) will be randomly drawn at the windup event from all registered participants.

NOTE: you do not have to catch a fish to be eligible for the random prize draws.

- Winning entries for the hidden length and time will be based on the following priority: length then time. In the event of more than one winner, in both length and time, the prize will be divided equally among all winners.

- As the fish are to be released immediately and will not be in the angler's possession, all fish are eligible for entry regardless of size.
- Participants are only eligible for one prize and participants do not need to be present at the windup event to be eligible for prizes.
- PRIZE STRUCTURE:**
 - 1st - \$10,000
 - 2nd - \$2,500
 - 3rd - Trip for two to Eagle Nest Lodge (value: \$2000)
 - 4th - \$1000
 - 5th - \$750
 - 6th - 50th Prize item random draw
- FISH MEASURING PROCESS:**

Fish will be measured by derby officials only. Derby officials will be stationed at various event locations.

The fish measuring process will be as follows:

 - Anglers are to announce they have a fish from their location/hole and wait for a derby official to go to the angler.
 - Derby official will measure the total length (pinched tail) and determine the time the fish was caught.
 - The fish will be released immediately after measuring.
 - The information will be recorded by the derby official and initialed by the angler as verification of the information.
- The derby will take place from 10:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. Anglers will be permitted on the ice at 8:00 a.m. to secure their angling hole. Angling may not take place prior to the 10:30 a.m. start time and must stop at 1:30 p.m. Walk-ons are welcome.
- The Awards & Prizes ceremony will take place at the Lac du Bonnet Community Centre after 1:30. Refreshments, food & bar will be made available.
- The participants indemnify and hold harmless the Derby Committee and its officials with respect to any injuries or claims arising from this competitive fishing event.
- In the event that any dispute arises between the Derby Committee and participants in relation to these rules and the dispute is not resolved by negotiation, the Derby Committee will have the final say.
- Prizes will be based on a minimum of 500 derby entries.
